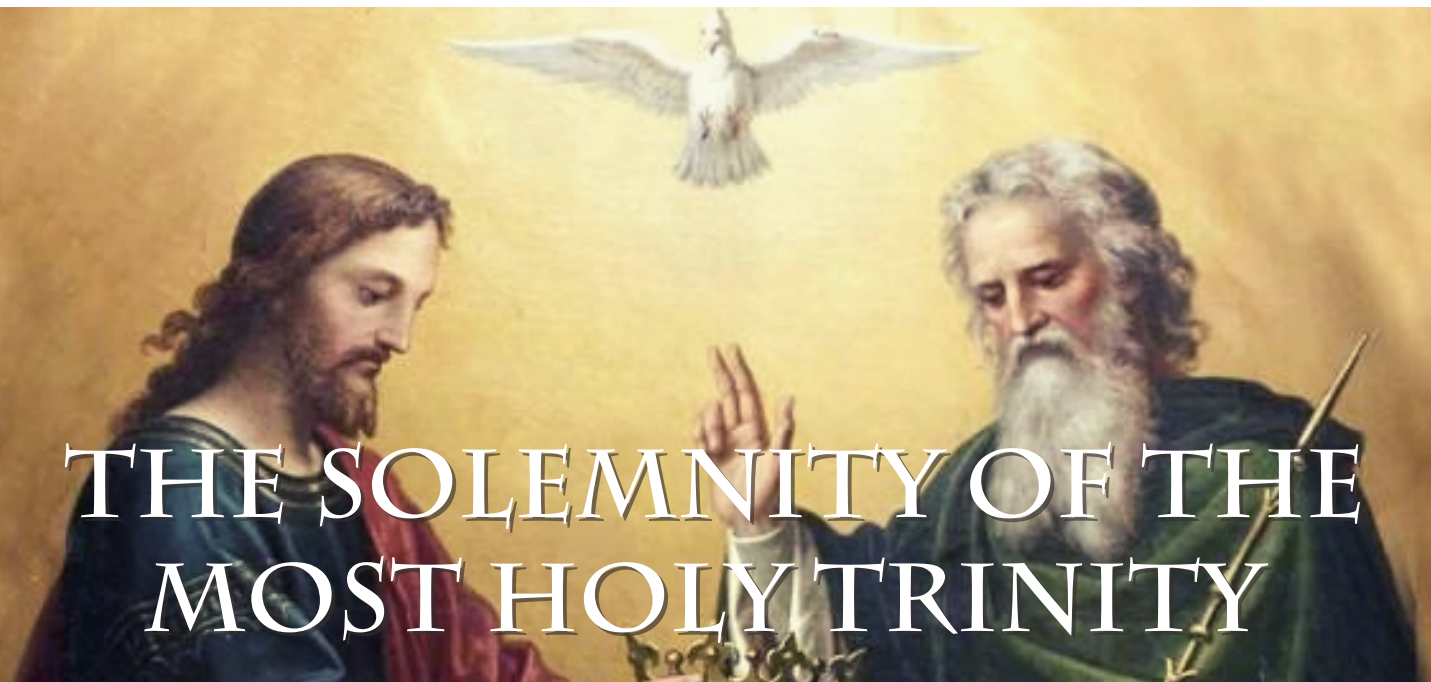

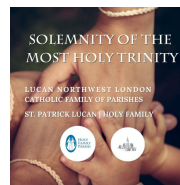


## A MESSAGE FROM FR. BOB REMARK, PASTOR

## Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ - Reception of the Eucharist

Receiving the Eucharist on the tongue. Beginning with the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Jesus (Corpus Christi), we invite the faithful, if they desire, to receive the Eucharist on the tongue. Here at Holy Family, these parishioners are invited to receive directly from the presiding priest who will distribute the Eucharist near the organ console, after he distributes Holy Communion to those in the church who are not able to come forward to the front of the church. Please keep in mind when receiving in this way, to make it as easy as possible to distribute Communion without having to touch a person's tongue. To protect the communicant and the priest from the spread of Covid, the priest will sanitize his hands after each person receives on the tongue. Many thanks!

The priest, once retired, is responsible for their own room and board. If nursing care is needed, it is the responsibility of the priest to provide the funds for this.

The priest pension fund uses the donations given through the generosity of the people of the Diocese of London to supplement the funds received from the government pension fund. Thank you for your generosity in helping the priests that would often spend 50+ years serving the good people of the diocese.

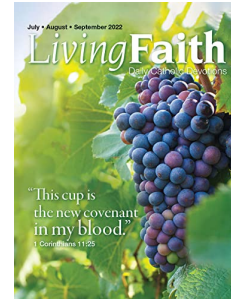
